This is the last Will and Testament of me **Enoch JUBB** the Younger of Thurlstone in the Parish of Penistone in the County of York, Slubber.

I devise and bequeath all the real and personal estate to which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease unto my wife **Martha Ann JUBB** absolutely but as to the estates vested in me upon trust or by way of mortgage subject to the trusts and equities affecting the same respectively.

And I appoint the said **Martha Ann JUBB** sole executrix of this my Will hereby revoking all other Testamentary writings.
