1 Page 1 - The last Will and Testament of George JUBB of Berrymoor
2 in the Township of Thurgoland in the West Riding of the County
3 of York Tailor made this fifth day of November in the year of
4 our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight. 1st I
5 will and hereby direct that my just debts funeral expenses and
6 probate of this my last Will and Testament be duly paid as
7 hereinafter directed. Secondly As soon as convenient after my
8 decease my Executor shall dispose of so much of my property
9 situate at Berrymoor in the Township of Thurgoland as will
10 pay all my debts funeral expenses and expenses of this my
11 last Will and Testament. I then give devise and bequeath unto
12 my Daughter the residue or remainder of my property above
13 mentioned together with all my other property real and personal
14 for the term of her natural life. Thirdly I further will and
15 direct that at the decease of my daughter the whole of the property
16 situate as above mentioned together with all other property which
17 does or may belong to me at the time of my decease shall
18 belong to James WALKER of Stainbro his executors administrators
19 or assigns for ever subject to the regulations mentioned in the
20 above clauses. And I hereby appoint the aforesaid James
21 ¹ WALKER Trustee under this my last Will and Testament with
22 full power to carry the same into execution and to be paid all
23 reasonable expenses out of the above mentioned property? For
24 so doing. In witness whereof I have this day and year above
25 written affixed my hand and seal in presence of the subscriber
26 under mentioned . George JUBB Signed sealed
27 published pronounced and declared by the above named
28 Testator in the presence of us the subscribers and in the
29 presence of each other the day and year above written

37 annexed? and bearing date of the fifth day of November one thousand eight
38 hundred and fifty eight and that the said Testator executed the said
39 will on the day of the date thereof by signing his name at the foot
40 and thereof as the same now appears thereon in the presence of me and
41 of [John Robinson ROCKINGS](#) of Berry Moor aforesaid Colliery Banksman
42 the other subscribed witness thereto both of us being present at the same
43 time and we thereupon attested and subscribed the said Will in the
44 presence of the said Testator. And I further make Oath and say that
45 previously to the execution of the said Will by the said Testator the
46 same was read over to him by me and the the said Testator at
47 such time seemed? thoroughly to understand and approve of the
48 contents of his said will. [W TATTERSHALL](#) – sworn by the
49 said [William TATTERSHALL](#) at Barnsley in the County of York this fifth day
50 of September 1860 before me [William SHEPHERD](#) a commissioner to administer
51 Oaths in the Court of Probate.
